Paediatric and Perinatal Epidemiology invites submissions addressing the role of climate change on reproductive, perinatal, and pediatric health outcomes. Submissions should examine the present-day or projected future health impacts of climate-sensitive exposures, including, but not limited to:

- Air pollution
- Ambient temperature
- Wildfire smoke
- Hurricanes and other severe storms
- Other extreme weather events

Submissions should include epidemiologic data on reproduction, pregnancy, perinatal and neonatal health, or child health outcomes, and should directly address the exposure-outcome relation in the context of continued climate change.

The deadline for submissions is **31 March 2021**. This special issue is intended for publication in fall 2021. Early access versions of accepted articles will be available online soon after acceptance.
