Special Issue on Environmental Issues and Policy

Introduction

The Journal of Public Economic Theory (JPET) aims to publish a special issue addressing various environmental economic issues facing policy makers nowadays.

Environmental issues broadly construed form a topic of increasing urgency. In recent years, notable theoretical advances were achieved in coalition formation games, decision theory, dynamic games, R&D and market structure, growth theory, and the economics of uncertainty, among other research areas. The purpose of this special issue is to bring some of these advances to bear on pressing environmental concerns and policy questions of the present time.

In particular, we welcome high-quality papers that cover the following topics:

- International environmental agreements
- Environmental innovation and green technologies
- Cost-benefit analysis for long-run climate-related issues, such as appropriate objectives and discounting, mitigation vs. adaptation measures, etc...
- Environmental regulatory instruments: taxes, standards, permits, etc...
- Management of natural resources
- Political economy approaches
- Methodological approaches and tools such as coalition formation games, dynamic optimization and dynamic games
