

Call for Associate Editor and Assistant Editor Applications

Wiley invites individuals to apply for the positions of Associate or Assistant Editor for the *Journal of Community Psychology (JCOPI)* to join incoming Editor-in-Chief Christine Ohannessian in leading the journal.

The *Journal of Community Psychology* is a peer-reviewed journal focusing on research, evaluation, assessment, and intervention, emphasizing empirical work on community factors that influence human behavior and development. The journal publishes articles across a variety of topics including descriptions and evaluations of service programs; studies of youth, parenting, and family development; and studies focusing on the identification of risk and protective factors involved in emotional and behavioral disorders across the lifespan.

We welcome various article types and methodologies (quantitative and qualitative), and value good scientific practice. We warmly welcome research from around the world and cover all areas of community psychology research.

Associate and Assistant Editors work together as part of the Editorial team, supporting the Editor-in-Chief in commissioning and coordinating the peer review of papers, and advising on journal development.

Associate and Assistant Editors should have:

- Ph.D. in Community Psychology, Developmental Psychology, Social Work, Clinical Psychology, or a related discipline
- A solid track record of research publications and conference presentations
- Local and/or international contact networks
- Editorial board experience and/or experience as a high-quality reviewer
- Sound judgement about how to conduct diverse forms of research
- Excellent written and verbal communication
- Ability to work on tight deadlines

We anticipate that Associate Editor applicants will have previous experience serving as an Associate Editor or Assistant Editor or have extensive experience serving as a reviewer for peer-reviewed journals or funding institutions (e.g., NIH, NSF, foundations). Assistant Editor applicants should also have experience serving as a reviewer but need not have prior experience serving as an Associate Editor or Assistant Editor for a peer-reviewed journal (early career applicants are encouraged to apply).

Candidates with expertise in mixed methods, qualitative methods, psychometrics/measurement, and advanced quantitative statistical methods are especially encouraged to apply. However, all areas of expertise will be considered. The role comes with a modest honorarium. We are looking for candidates who are available for an immediate start.
