



Rules and Guidelines

The contest aims to promote the interest for the science and technology and give the opportunity to researchers to outreach their findings creating original short videos.

1. Who can participate?

- The contest is open to all PhD students, postdoctoral researchers, PIs and Professors, as long as their video is related to at least one of their own articles published in *Chemistry – A European Journal* before the **contest deadline – October 30, 2020 00:00 pm GMT**.
- Participants of the video competition to celebrate the 25th anniversary of *Chemistry – A European Journal* “A Short-Video Competition” agree to the *Terms of Use*.

2. How to participate?

- Participants need to fill the registration form available online at www.chemeurj.org/25.
- Participants will send the video via e-mail or a transfer link/platform (dropbox, onedrive, wetransfer...).
- **The registration form and original video (or video link) should be sent via e-mail to chemistry@wiley-vch.de with “Video Competition” as the subject line.**
- The videos have to be original, scientifically accurate and up to 3 minutes in length.
- The videos need to fulfill the Youtube video requirements. For more information check the following [Youtube video specs link](#).
- Contestants can submit one or more videos. Each submission requires the corresponding registration form, video and e-mail.
- Submissions will be accepted from March 10, 2020 00:01 am GMT through October 30, 2020 00:00 pm GMT. An extension of the deadline might be provided if it is considered necessary.
- The video will be uploaded to the ChemistryViews.org YouTube Channel. *Chemistry – A European Journal* webpage will also provide a direct link to access the video. ChemistryViews.org is the international magazine of ChemPubSoc Europe, an organization of 16 European chemical societies. It is closely linked to *Chemistry – A European Journal*, which is also owned by ChemPubSoc Europe.

3. Evaluation

- The editorial office of *Chemistry – A European Journal* will pre-select up to 10 videos, which will be finally evaluated by our jury, formed by a selection of board-members.
- Winning videos will be announced online. Winners will be notified by e-mail a few days in advance.

4. Prizes

The jury will award 3 prizes.

- The videos cannot be used in a former or current independent competition.
- Videos must not have been previously released in any other platform before the competition.
- Wiley-VCH employees and their family members may participate, but are ineligible to win.
- All submitted videos are subject to approval and may not be accepted if they are found to be offensive or in violation of copyright. See *Terms of Use*.
- Videos not complying with the eligibility criteria will be automatically rejected.
- Wiley-VCH reserve the right to use submitted videos in Chemistry webpage, ChemViews Magazine, and the ChemistryViews.org website and in other promotions.
