

The EACS Early Career Award in Structural Control & Health Monitoring

The EACS Early Career Award in Structural Control & Health Monitoring recognises published research marking a significant step forward in our understanding of structural control.

The Award will be given annually (commencing 2022) and announced on the homepage of *Structural Control and Health Monitoring*. The award winner will be decided by a judging panel, including members of the EACS and journal's editorial board.

The winner will receive a cash prize of 500 USD (or equivalent) and a certificate.

Papers representing work completed within **three years** of PHD completion, are eligible. **The student must be the senior or sole author of the paper, and the content should represent largely independent work of the student, based on their own research.**
