BCPT Nordic Prize

The prize is given each year to an eminent scientist in either of the fields of basic and/or clinical pharmacology or toxicology in honour of a life-long effort to develop and promote either or both of the disciplines in a Nordic country as well as internationally.

The BCPT Nordic Prize 2022 of 15,000 EUR was awarded to Professor Kim Brøsen, MD, University of Southern Denmark – Odense, Denmark.

BCPT Young Researcher Nordic Prize

The prize is given each year to honour the achievements of an outstanding young research talent in either of the fields of basic and/or clinical pharmacology or toxicology in the Nordic region.

The BCPT Young Researcher Nordic Prize 2022 of 7,500 EUR was awarded to Associate Professor Tore B. Stage, MScPharm, University of Southern Denmark – Odense, Denmark.

BCPT Young Investigator's Award

On the basis of invited Focused Reviews, authored by newly graduated PhDs and published in 2022, the BCPT Young Investigator's Award 2022 of 1500 EUR was awarded to Stella Karsten, MD, Resident in Clinical Immunology and Transfusion Medicine, Karolinska University Hospital, Stockholm, Sweden.
