

The Editors of *Andrology* are now accepting nominations for Editorial Board membership through February 28, 2022.

Process

Editorial Board members are nominated by andrology colleagues and serve by invitation. To nominate someone, please write a short recommendation letter addressed to the Editors and send it to the *Andrology* office at andrology.office@wiley.com. Self-nominations are welcome.

The main duty of an *Andrology* Editorial Board (EB) member is to:

- Review submitted manuscripts as requested by the Associate Editors within Scholar One deadlines

We also expect the EB members to:

- Submit articles for publication in *Andrology*
- If requested, nominate new EB members
- Attend the annual EB via conference call or in person

We will, in particular, encourage applications from younger, mid-career experts in different aspects of andrology, who are motivated for qualifying as future Associate Editors of the journal.

A CV of the candidate should be attached to the letter of nomination. After a nomination has been received, the Board of Associate Editors will review and determine whether to issue or decline an invitation. This will depend on the scholarly achievements of the nominee and the needs of the journal in a particular area of andrology. Main focus will be given to list of publications, previous experience in assessment of scientific papers, stage of research career, and clinical/research area of expertise.
